



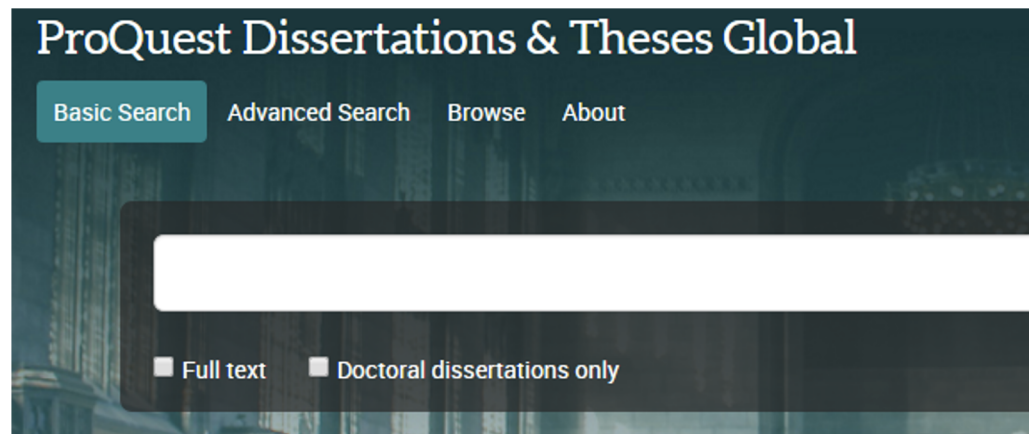

ProQuest Databases

We subscribe to two ProQuest Databases:

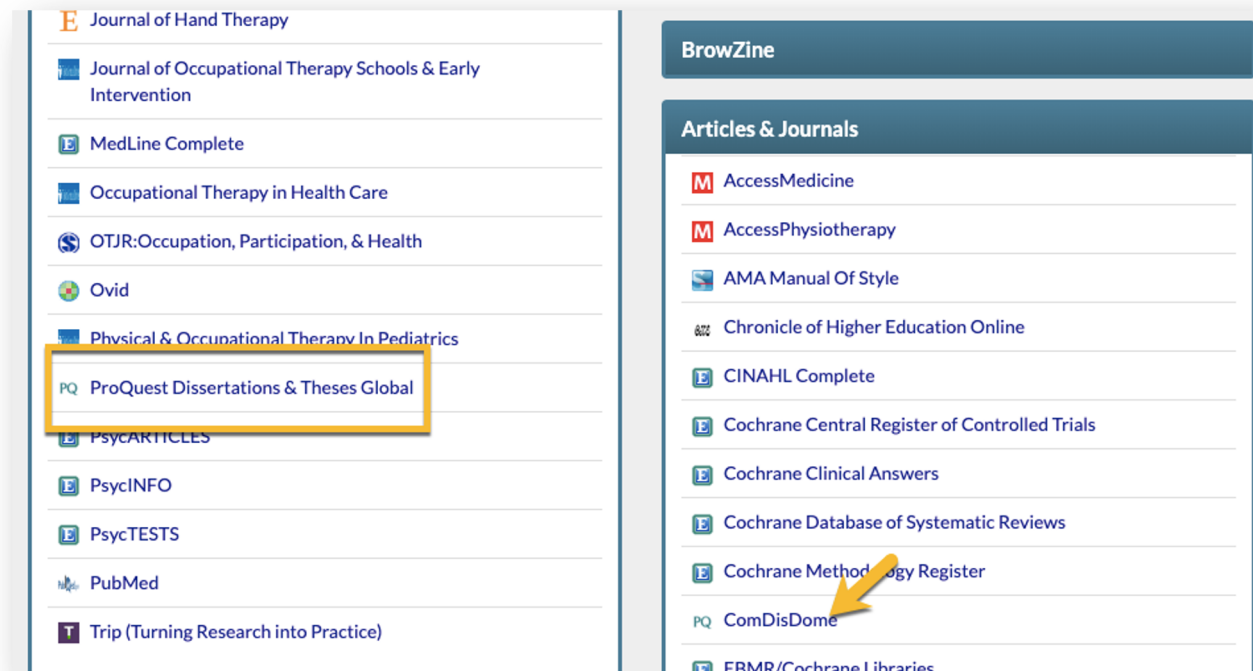
- ProQuest Dissertation and Theses Global (DTG)—Contains 5 million citations and 2.5 million full-text works.
- ComDisDome (Communications Disorders)—Indexing and abstracting tool covering communications disorders literature, with focus on speech-language pathology and audiology.

These can be searched separately or together. The search features are the same for both.



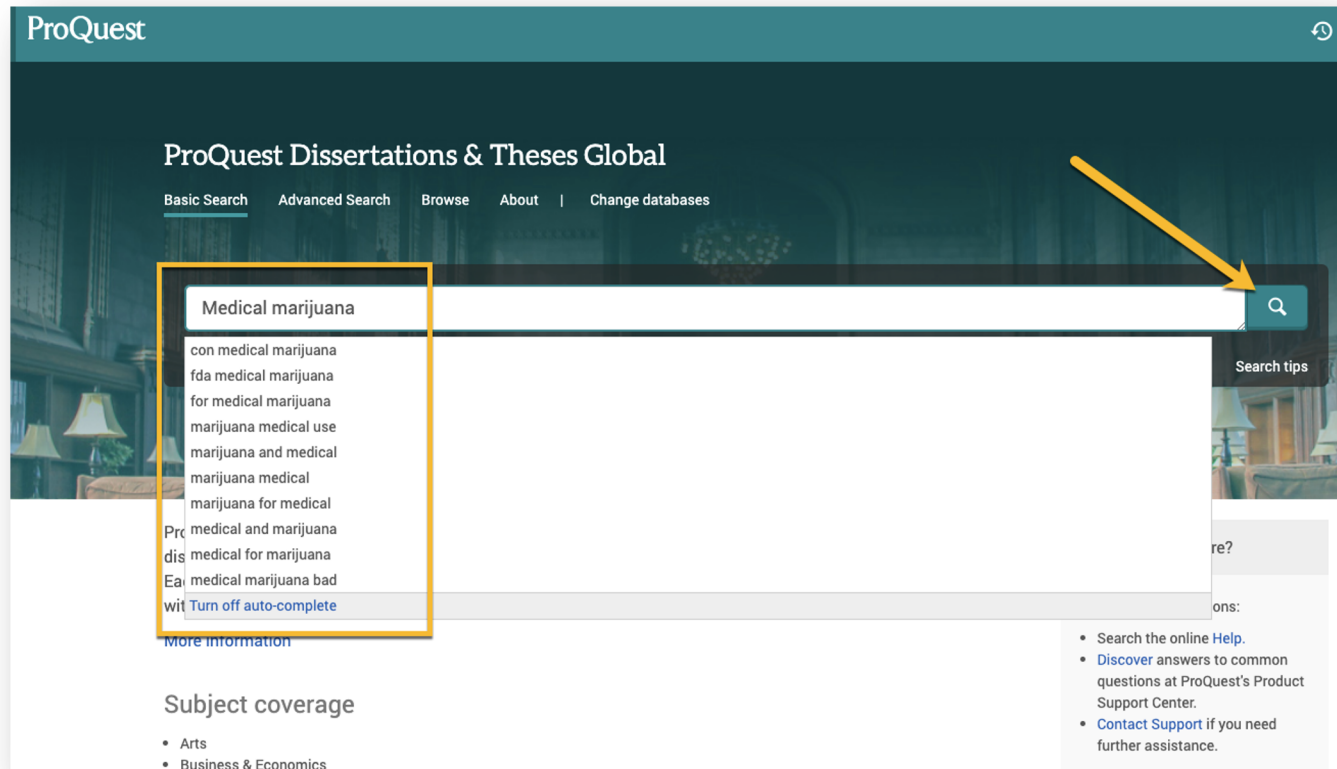
Searching Both Databases

To search both databases, start by searching one. In LibLynx, click on ProQuest Dissertations & Theses Global. Notice ComDisDome on the side.





Searching Both Databases

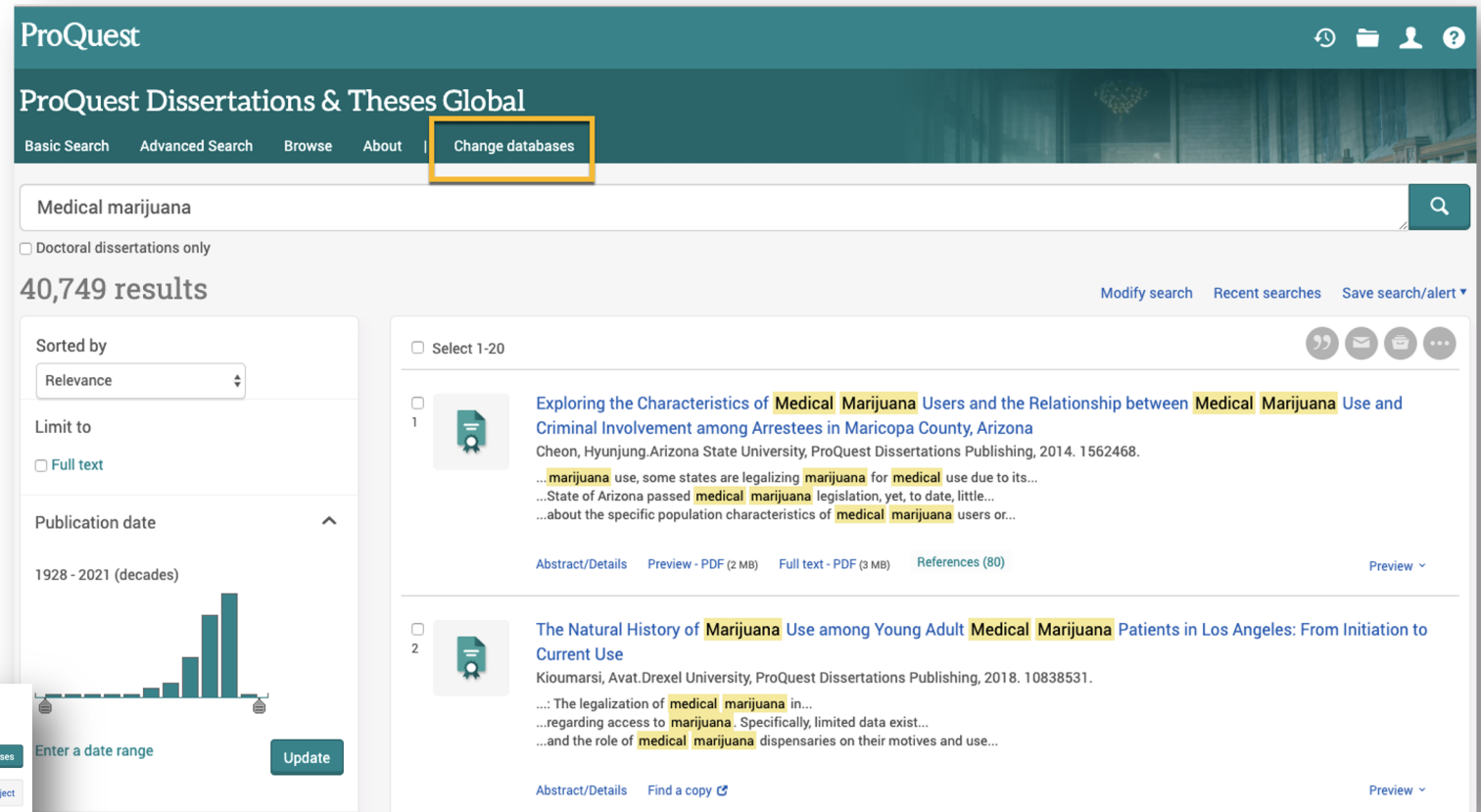
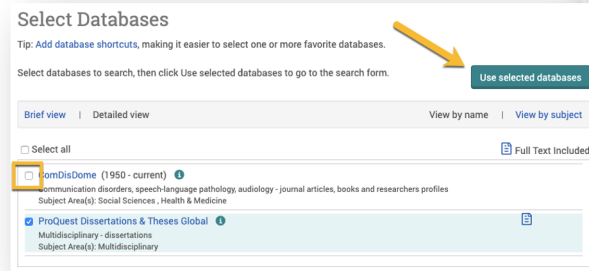


Typing search terms in the Basic Search box, notice the suggested terms. Select one or click search.



Searching Both Databases

Results are almost 41,000. Impressive. If you want to include ComDisDome in your search, click on Change databases. Click on the box next to ComDisDome.





Recent Searches

You will have to run your search a second time. Click on Recent Search to see the search you just ran, then Actions, Modify Search, and then click on Search. The result remained the same. Medical Marijuana isn't really a SLP topic.

You can request dissertations and theses through Interlibrary. To obtain a dissertation from another university it involves their willingness to fill our request. For this dissertation, we would have to contact Drexel University library. We are glad to do it but understand they may deny the request.



Advanced Search

Let's run an advanced search with a topic that is more ComDisDome friendly.

Notice we are searching 2 databases. We can narrow where we want our search terms to appear, i.e., abstract, author. Because we are searching DTG, we have some additional boxes for advisor and university.

Advanced Search

We have seen this layout before with EBSCO and PubMed. Notice the synonyms for bipolar or manic depression. You can use the multiple boxes or the Tinker Toy method.
